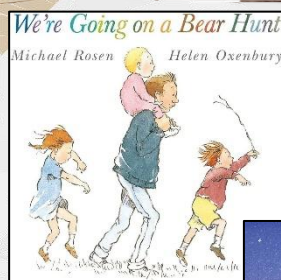

We're Going On A Bear Hunt

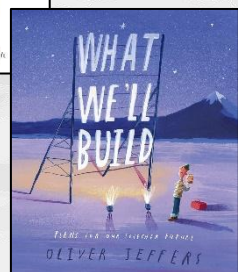
Pupils will immerse themselves into a famous children's classic, retelling the story using actions rhymes and will begin to make observations on the front cover by using the phonics they have been learning.

We are reading...



What We'll Build

Children will be learning new skills such as prediction by observing the front cover for clues. They will build on their phonetic knowledge and begin to write words and captions whilst continuing to learn how to sequence their new story.



Maths

Just like me!

The first unit of White Rose Maths in Reception introduces key mathematical concepts through play and exploration. Children focus on matching, sorting, and comparing objects based on size, colour, and shape. They begin to understand amounts by comparing quantities and explore size, weight, and capacity. The unit also introduces simple patterns and positional language, helping children describe the location of objects. This unit lays the foundation for number sense and spatial reasoning, using everyday experiences to develop early math skills.

Learning Adventure

Let's Explore

This project teaches children about the environments that they share with others, including their homes, school and places in the local community.

Build It Up

This project teaches children about structures and materials and gives them the opportunity to work in groups to create collaborative structures.



PSHE

Being Me In My World

This unit focuses on helping children develop a sense of identity, belonging, and understanding of their place in the world. Through activities and discussions, children learn about themselves, their feelings, and the importance of being part of a community, such as their class or family. The unit introduces concepts like respecting others, following rules, and understanding rights and responsibilities, helping children build confidence, self-awareness, and positive relationships with their peers.



Music

Me!

This unit focuses on introducing young children to the world of music through songs, movement, and play. It encourages children to explore their voices, sing simple songs, and experiment with sounds. The unit helps develop listening skills, rhythm, and an awareness of pitch, while introducing basic musical concepts like loud/quiet and fast/slow.



PE

Fine & Gross Motor Skills

In this unit, children are introduced to basic physical abilities such as running, jumping, balancing, and catching. The activities are designed to help children develop coordination, control, and spatial awareness. Through fun games and movement-based exercises, they learn to follow instructions, build confidence in their physical abilities, and engage in active play, laying the foundation for a healthy, active lifestyle.

Dance

The dance unit for Reception in PE Passport introduces children to basic movement and dance concepts through fun, creative activities. Children learn to express themselves using their bodies, exploring different ways of moving to music.
