### **Re: 30 Hour Nursery Provision**

We are looking to offer parents of Nursery aged children the chance of a 30 hour per week Nursery place. This is for children who are currently in our Nursery or planning to start Nursery soon.

Your eligibility will depend on:

- If you are working
- Your income (and your partner's income, if you have one)
- Your child's age and circumstances
- Your immigration status

You can usually get 30 hours' free childcare if your (and your partner) are in work, on sick leave or annual leave.

You may still be eligible if you're temporarily working less and either you are on furlough through the Coronavirus Job Retention Scheme or you're claiming a Self Employment Income Support Scheme Grant.

You may still be eligible if your partner is working and you get Incapacity Benefit, Severe Disablement Allowance, Carer's Allowance or contribution-based Employment and Support Allowance.

Please also note that if your child stays all day in Nursery, they will need a packed lunch, or you can purchase a lunch from school for them at a cost of £2.20 per day.

Please note: We will still be keeping the 15 hour provision for those who need it or wish to keep it.
