<u>Writing</u> Rosie's Walk

Pupil's will immerse themselves into fun on the farm with Rosie trying to escape the cheeky fox. Children will be able to use prediction throughout this story, guessing what will happen using clues from the text. They will also become more familiar of sequencing independently and move onto writing captions for what they have sequenced.

Maths

Alive in 5

Children will continue to familiarise themselves with numbers 1-5 children will be learning new skills and vocabulary such as equal and unequal and comparing numbers. Children will understand the composition further of these numbers and use songs and rhymes to help them understand and become fluent in recognising, counting and forming these numbers.

Growing 6,7,8

Children will be moving onto numbers beyond 5 and repeating the skills previously learned. They will be recognising numbers beyond 5 and understanding how to form, count and recognise these numbers with a good level of fluency. Children will also be exploring length measuring height and length comparing taller, shorter, longer rand shorter.

Learning Adventure

Ready Steady Grow

Children will learn about food and farming and explores themes, including where food comes from, what plants and animals need to grow and survive and what a healthy lifestyle is.

Signs of Spring

Children will be learning about the Changes that happen during the spring, including weather and the festivals that are celebrated at this time of year.

Healthy Me
