Pupils will be developing their understanding of print as well as learning how to recognise their own name and familiar logos.

Maths

Comparing

Pupils will develop their understanding of comparing and ordering sets of objects and will learn that a set can have more, the same or fewer objects than another set. They will learn to compare size, mass and Capacity by using language such as big, little, small and large, long and short.

Simple patterns

Pupils develop their understanding of copying, continuing, and creating patterns. They will learn how to say their patterns out loud and will create ABAB patterns.
