

Autumn 2 in Nursery



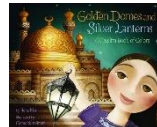
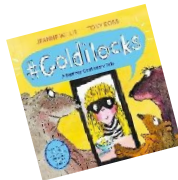
English

Pupils will be developing their understanding of print as well as learning how to recognise their own name and familiar logos.

We are reading...

When reading, pupils will be able to look at books independently and turn the pages. Pupils will engage in discussions linked to stories and will develop their vocabulary.

The stories that pupils will be exploring this half term links to the Learning Adventure project we are studying.



Maths

Comparing

Pupils will develop their understanding of comparing and ordering sets of objects and will learn that a set can have more, the same or fewer objects than another set. They will learn to compare size, mass and capacity by using language such as big, little, small and large, long and short.

Simple patterns

Pupils develop their understanding of copying, continuing, and creating patterns. They will learn how to say their patterns out loud and will create ABAB patterns.

Learning Adventure

Once upon a time

This project supports children to develop a love of stories and reading. It encourages children to learn, retell and act out familiar and traditional tales including Cinderella, Goldilocks, Little Red Riding Hood, The Three Little Pigs and The Three Billy Goats Gruff.

Sparkle and shine

This project teaches children about the celebrations that take place during the autumn and winter seasons and focus on the significance and symbolism of light at this time of year.



PSHE

Celebrating difference

In this unit, children are encouraged to think about things that they are good at whilst understanding that everyone is good at different things.

They talk about being different and how that makes everyone special but also recognising that we are the same in some ways. The children talk about their homes and are asked to explain why it is special to them. They talk about friendship and how to be a kind friend and how to stand up for themselves if someone says or does something unkind to them.



Music

My Stories

This music project will allow children to listen and respond to different styles of music. We will be learning and singing a variety of nursery rhymes such as 'Hey diddle, diddle,' '5 little ducks' and 'Twinkle, twinkle little star.' We will also be exploring different festivals through music such as Christmas. We will also begin learning our songs for our Christmas nativity performance!

PE

Fine motor control- Pupils will learn how to pick up and put down objects with care. They will develop their ability to thread with control and manipulate objects using strength in their hands.

Stability- Pupils will practise balancing on one leg and whilst lifting or carrying something. Furthermore, they will explore different types of jumps and will learn how to dodge.
