PUNCTUALITY - please ensure your child arrives on time and are in school before 9.00am. We had an excellent start to the new school year with very few children being late. Unfortunately the lates are now on the increase. The Education Welfare Service have been informed and they will be doing some "Late Gates" in the near future

ATTENDANCE - is currently at 95% for the whole school. We are looking to achieve 96% and beyond. Please ensure that your child attends school every day.

HEADLICE

We have had a lot of cases of head lice in school recently. Please ensure that you check your child's hair regularly. If your child does have head lice, advice from the NHS School Nursing Team is: Use lots of conditioner (any cheap one will do) and comb through with a head lice comb to remove any eggs or lice. You will need to repeat this process several times. Ask your pharmacist for advice if you have tried wet combing for 2 weeks, but your child still has head lice or nits—they may recommend using medicated lotions and sprays. There's nothing you can do to prevent them but you can reduce the risk of lice spreading by avoiding head-to-head contact. Your child does NOT need to stay off school if they have head lice.




TEACHERS' CORNER / SCHOOL NEWS

COLLECTING CHILDREN

Statements will be coming out to all parents who owe money for dinners to the school. Please make payments via our online payment system, Scopay.
