#### **After School Club**

Last year, we trialled a paid after school childcare club, which was a great success! We are now pleased to confirm that we have started running the club at the end of every school day at a cost of just £6.00 per session. The session starts when the school bell rings and finishes at 5.15pm. There will be a small snack and drink provided to the children daily.

Due to staffing numbers and for health and safety reasons, children will not be able to attend if you haven't booked and paid

until the morning of the day you wish your child to attend.

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### **REMINDERS AND UPDATES:**

## **Morning and End of Day Update**

We are no longer using the one way system onto the school premises that was implemented last year during the Covid Epidemic, so you can now enter and exit the school premises via either gate. But please still be mindful and considerate of others by keeping a safe distance at all times whilst on the premises.

A reminder that start and finish times are as follows:

Nursery: Start at 8:45am, Finish at 11:45am (30 hour children—finish at 3:20pm)

Reception —Year 6: Start at 8:50am, Finish at 3:20pm

Please ensure that your child attends school every day and is on time for school every morning ready to start learning. It is also just as important that you are on time collecting them at the end of the day. It can be very upsetting for children if parents are not there to collect them when they are expected to, and our teaching staff have other commitments after school so are unable to stay and look after any children who have not been collected on time.

From the start of term, we will be closely monitoring all absences and late arrivals/collections. Parents will be issued with warning letters once any child's attendance reaches below our expected attendance level of 95%.

#### **PE Days**

All children will have a PE lesson each week as follows. The lessons will be led by our Sports Coaches from Soccer 2000.

Reception: Thursday
Year 1 and Year 2: Monday
Year 3 and Year 4: Tuesday
Year 5 & Year 6: Thursday

In addition to the above set days, all classes will also have other PE activities throughout each week so please ensure that every child brings their PE kit in each Monday morning and takes it home for washing each Friday.

ALL pupils will need to follow the school's PE uniform requirements. This will be monitored closely and you will be informed if your child is not in the correct PE kit. Children who are not wearing the correct kit or unsuitable kit will not be allowed to take part in the lessons for health and safety reasons.

## PE Kit for Boys and Girls is as follows:

- ☑ Purple or white tee shirt (plain or school logo)
- ☑ Plain black shorts/plain black jogging bottoms
- ☑ Plain black or purple sweatshirt/hoodie (purple hoodies with school logo are available to buy from Trutex)
- ☑ Black pumps/trainers

(Please note: Children should not be wearing named brand items (eg: Nike, Adidas etc)

Don't forget to label all uniform with your child's name!

#### **Year 5 Swimming Lessons**

In addition to their weekly PE lesson, Year 5 children will be having swimming lessons at Bentley Bridge every Tuesday afternoon. Please remember to send your child with their swimming kit each week: swimming costume/swimming shorts, towel, swimming hat and goggles if required.

### **Uniform Requirements**

We know that it is sometimes difficult at the start of new school terms to get new uniform for your children due to stock issues at the uniform suppliers/shops etc, so we understand that some children have returned to school not in the correct uniform.

However, in the next few weeks, we will be monitoring this and expect that all children come to school in the correct uniform. If any children are not wearing their full, correct uniform, we will be contacting parents.

A reminder of uniform requirements is below:

#### **Girls**

Grey/black skirt or trousers
Purple polo shirt (with logo)
Purple sweatshire/cardigan (with logo)
Black shoes (not trainers)

Purple and white gingham dress for summer

#### **Boys**

Grey/black trousers
Purple polo shirt (with logo)
Purple sweatshirt (with logo)
Black shoes (not trainers)

### **School Meals — Chartwells Catering Services**

Due to this, they advise that they may have to amend and change the menus at short notice, but please be reassured that their priority and our priority is to ensure that all children receive a nutritious meal each day.

If your child misses the first 15 minutes of school daily, they will never have spelling delivered to them at Bushbury Lane. Your child deserve to access these lessons.

Please be aware that we will be sending letters out to those families where we are concerned about attendance and will have our Education Welfare Officer involved.
