



## Coming Back to School in September

Dear Parents and Carers

We are really looking forward to seeing you and your children in September; here is some information about the measures we have put in place to reopen.

### Social Distancing

- Please ensure that you use the one-way system that is in place – this is signposted and arrows also show which way to travel through the playground;
- Markings have been placed around your child's entrance/exit door, please stay outside these to keep 2m apart from the class teachers and other children;
- Please ensure you social distance when on the playground and leave the school premises as soon as you have dropped off or collected your child/ren;
- Only one person should drop off and collect your child to avoid having extra people on site;
- If you have any questions for the class teacher, please use class dojo instead of asking questions in person;

### Dropping off and Collecting Your Children

- Please try to walk to school if at all possible: this is to ensure Rippon Road doesn't get too congested with traffic;
- Please stick to the times above to ensure we can minimise the amount of people on the school site as much as possible;

## Frequently Asked Questions

### My child is not feeling very well – what should I do?

If your child has been, or is unwell you should **NOT** bring them to school. If a child begins to display symptoms of Coronavirus during the day they will be isolated in a designated area (First Aid room). Parents/Carers will be contacted to collect their child immediately. Staff will be wearing full PPE during any isolation.

The child will be required to be tested and isolated while waiting for the results. If the result is negative they may return to school. If it is positive, the family will need to continue to isolate for 14 days.

If there is a confirmed case of Coronavirus within a bubble, all children and staff from the 'bubble' will be required to isolate for 14 days.

If you or a member of your household are contacted by NHS track and trace and told to isolate you **MUST** follow this and inform school.

### Can my child have a hot school dinner?

- We will be serving hot dinners from the kitchen again;
- If you would prefer to bring your own that is fine;
- If you are bringing your own lunch, please put this in a bag that can be thrown away at school where possible to reduce the risk of transmission.

### Will breakfast club be available?

Yes, if you would like a place at breakfast club, please contact the office to arrange this.

### How will lunchtimes and break times work within school?

Lunchtimes and breaktimes have been timetabled so children do not mix with anyone from outside their bubble. Bubbles will be as follows: Nursery/Reception; Year 1/2/3; Year 4/5/6.

### What will happen at break time with social distancing?

Children will be in their bubble during break times.

### Why can't we walk back round to Rippon Road when we exit the one-way system?

A lot of careful consideration has gone into keeping everyone safe; we have decided to put the new one-way system in place as there is only one footpath on Rippon Road. It is not possible to socially distance effectively enough with only one footpath and we did not want people putting themselves at risk by walking in the road as there will be a lot of cars present.
